What is the priesthood of all believers? by Craig Troxel Suggested by our Members

The doctrine of the priesthood of all believers is a cardinal principle of the churches of the 16th-century Reformation. It is often mentioned but, sadly, not truly understood. Troxel's book provides a solid foundation for understanding this important and practical Christian teaching by anchoring the idea firmly in the work of Christ.

Troxel explains that every believer has a unique ministry and the ability to carry it out. He addresses questions such as whether pastors have greater access to God and whether church offices are necessary. The health of the church depends on correctly understanding our encouraging position in Christ. We would do well to read and take to heart Craig Troxel's admonition in this work and spend some time reflecting on what our Lord intends for us as we seek to live faithfully bi-vocationally.
